Four Northshore Graduates Awarded College-Sponsored National Merit Scholarship

Bothell, Wash. – Inglemoor 2021 graduates Dace Roberts and Kimaya Wijeratna, as well as Woodinville 2021 graduates Benjamin Sehmel and Aria Yang, each received a college-sponsored National Merit Scholarship in July. Wijeratna and Yang received a scholarship for Tufts University, Roberts for the University of Southern California and Sehmel for the University of Utah.

These four students join Woodinville's Elliot Smith and more than 3,100 other collegesponsored award recipients who were announced in June.

Officials of each sponsor college selected their scholarship winners from among the finalists in the 2021 National Merit Scholar Program who plan to attend their institution.
