Summary

- Middle Schools start times between 7:50-7:55 am
- High Schools start between 8:15-8:20 am
- Elementary Schools no later than 4:05 pm dismissal
- Requires driver replacement of those that retired only (no additional)
- Implementation uses current fleet – no additional buses required
- Program bus replacement for old buses is already in process
- May be minor adjustments in special program times-Phonology based on bell time when placement is decided



Phase 2: Full Compliance with Board Resolution 714



Phase 2 – September 2022

Full implementation of Resolution 714
(start times at or after 8 and end times by 4)

- Continued work by District staff
 - Leveraging the efforts of Transpo Group
- Learning from Phase 1 implementation
- Experience with new technology

History of this Work





Background: History

- **This work started at least ten years ago**, some community members on the current Technical Workgroup have been involved all along the way.
- **Efforts have involved**, staff, consultants (technical experts) and community members.

A few comments from our workgroup members involved

During my tenure as a bus driver, I have transported students to ALL schools in our district, providing me the opportunity to opine on all the different aspects of traffic, congestion areas, areas of concern, and most importantly the need for better and safer ingress and egress access points to maximize safety and efficiency of our Transportation system.

This recommendation comes after at least a decade of discussion, a multi-year task force and multiple meetings by administrators, teachers, school bus drivers, parents and community leaders. We should all remember the initial reason for these changes: 40+ years of scientific research tells us that high schoolers starting too early leads to lower academic results, depression and even suicides. Technology Improvements: Improving Safety and Efficiency



“My Stop”

- Allows parents the ability to track timing of bus arrival at each stop in route on phone

“Tyler Drive”

- Tablet mounted in each bus with anticipated rider’s names.
- Tracking status of students on buses and confirming each student gets to the right stop

Both in testing phase currently

Fully deployed in September 2021

Next Steps

Committed to Phase 2





Phase 2: Compliance with Board Policy

- Board Policy
No school start times before 8 a.m. or dismissal after 4 p.m.
- Staff will:
 - Implement Phase 1 as described above
 - Learn from the changes that are occurring to support full implementation
 - Program moves to with each District region (where possible)
 - Move of all elementary music programs to within the school day (September 2021)
 - Purchase of additional buses needed for full implementation (already initiated)
 - Hiring of additional drivers to support full implementation
 - Improving ingress and egress at school sites where needed
 - Continue working with transportation experts and community members
 - Recommend a final phase 2 plan to the School Board

“I am very proud of the fact that this entire process has been very inclusive ... making sure that teachers, coaches, school bus drivers, union reps, administrators, parents and community leaders have all been invited to participate. Everyone was always very open to listen to different perspectives - which have been taken into consideration. No change ever makes everyone happy; but, with the help of traffic engineers and other experts in the field, I am confident that this is a good proposal which moves us in the right direction: helping students.”
