Families may not need or want to take their student's device home over the summer. Families who wish to opt out of keeping their student's assigned device will need to indicate that they are "opting out" by completing the form at <u>go.nsd.org/optout</u>. This form will help our staff to plan efficiently for sending devices home for summer learning. When students return to school in the Fall, any student who does not have an assigned device will be assigned one for school year learning.

Graduates will be seated in alphabetical order during the commencement ceremony. Students with last names **A-K** will be seated on the **VISITOR** (EAST) Side of Pop Keeney Field. Students with last names **Z-L** will be seated on the **HOME** (WEST) Side of the field, (Z's seated at the front and L's at the back).

If your student is a Valedictorian with last name **A-J**, they will be seated in the front row on the VISITOR SIDE. Valedictorians with last names **L-Z** will be seated in the front row of the HOME SIDE.
