
## **NNAT3 Directions for Students and Families**


- 1. Please submit the <u>attestation form</u> attached to your email, certifying that you will complete the test on your own without support from anyone in your home. This will be provided in a link in the email you received along with your password to take the NNAT3.
- 2. Connect your device to the Internet in your home if you have not already done so. Follow the instructions for your Internet service.
- 3. Do not login to the computer. Look in the lower left-hand corner of the screen for "Apps."



4. Go to the lower left hand corner of the screen, and click on the "waffle" until three items pop up: Secure TestBrowser, TestNav, and Riverside DataManager.



5. Click on the second choice, TestNav.


