- ALL Washington State schools are truly TEST OPTIONAL
- 10th grade families are included in the rare circumstance that a 10th grader wants to take the exam but it is NOT ENCOURAGED IN GENERAL and 11th graders will have first priority (their registration will start first)
- Fee waivers will be available for students receiving Free and Reduced Lunch
