1. ParentSquare

As you know, the District is launching ParentSquare as the platform for all future communications. Soon, this Family Bulletin will be available only via ParentSquare (but for a while, until everyone is signed up, I'll send it both via ParentSquare and via the old way as a PDF in an email).

You can activate your ParentSquare account in three ways:

Option 1:

- Use the email (or text message if you do not have an email on file with the District) that was sent to you on Jan. 9 from the sender ParentSquare, inviting you to join the platform.
 - When you click the button that reads "Activate your account" in the email, you will be asked to create a password and login using the email address you have on file with the District.

Option 2:

Visit the <u>ParentSquare website</u> and use the email account or phone number you have on file with the District to activate your account; or

Option 3:

Download the ParentSquare app on your iOS or Android phone and request activation. To take full advantage of ParentSquare's functionality we recommend everyone downloads the ParentSquare app for even easier access to school and District information.

Once you have activated your account, ParentSquare will connect you to your student(s) enrolled in our school and any other schools in Northshore.

After you're logged into your account, you can also access <u>help articles</u> for more information on navigating and using ParentSquare



6. Spring SAT test at NCHS

SAT School Day allows for students to take the SAT during the school day at their home high school. The SAT School Day exam for North Creek is set for March 22. The exam will start in the AM and will last approximately 3 1/2 hours.

Important information regarding the registration and payment of the exam:

Students register for the SAT School Day exam by going to <u>https://www.regismart.net/#/login</u>. Here, students will:

- CREATE ACCOUNT
- Select North Creek
- Register, and pay for the exam
- Details of the registration, fee, cancellation policy, are listed on the RegiSmart website

Students do not need to register for SAT School Day exam on the College Board website. However, if a student wants to take the SAT exam on a different date & location throughout the year, they must register for that exam on the <u>College Board SAT website</u>.


Please note: there is a maximum of 100 students who can take the SAT at NCHS.
