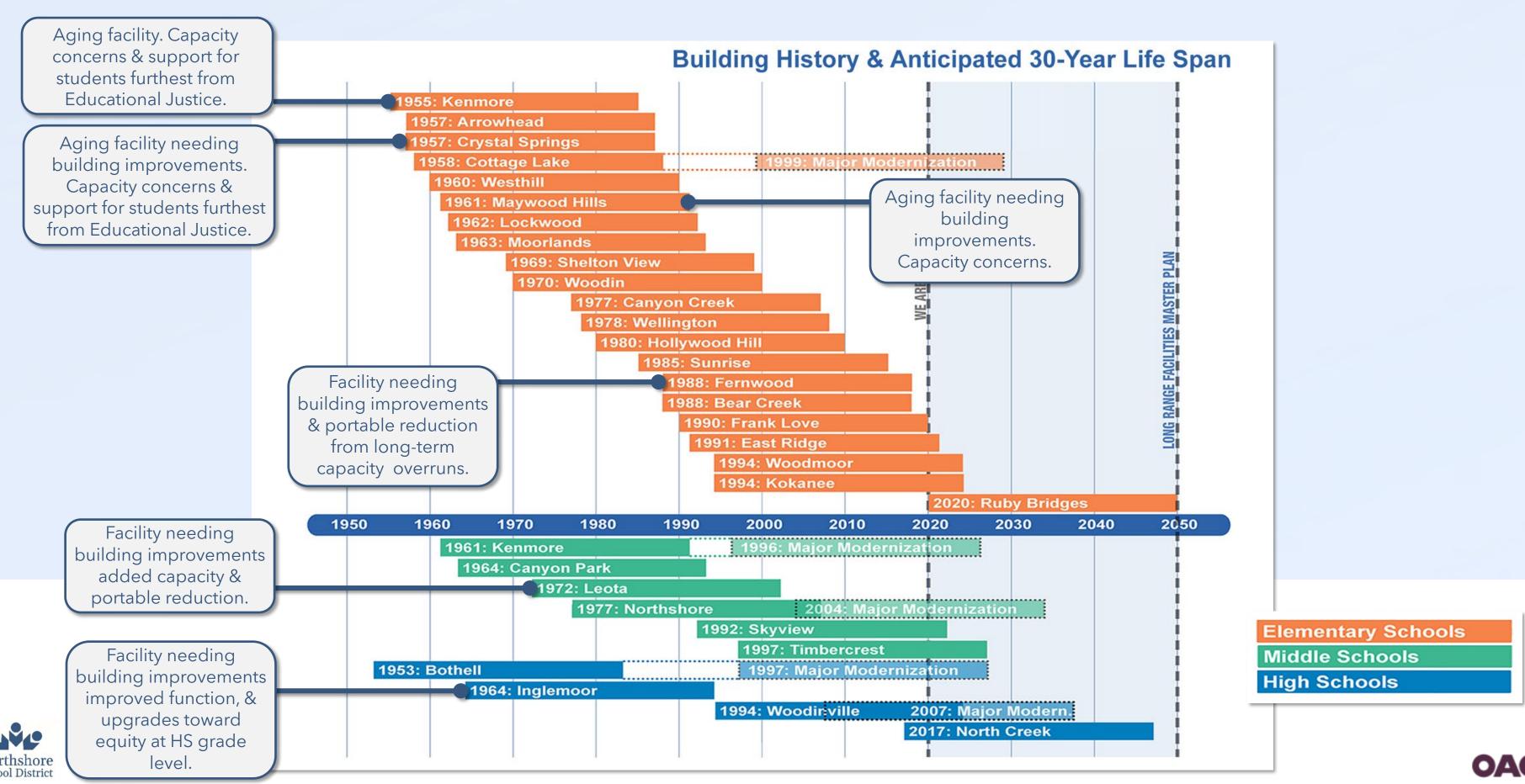




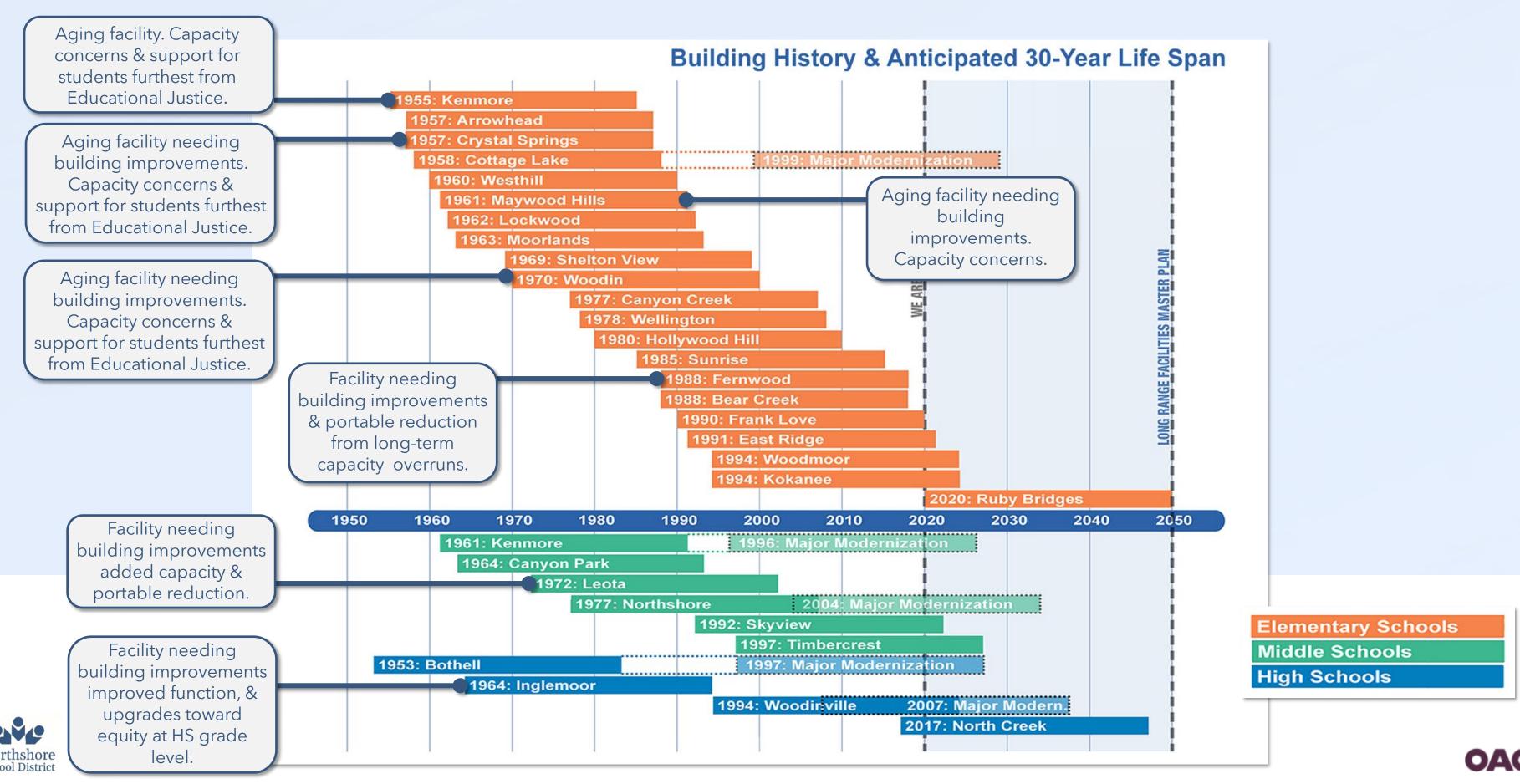


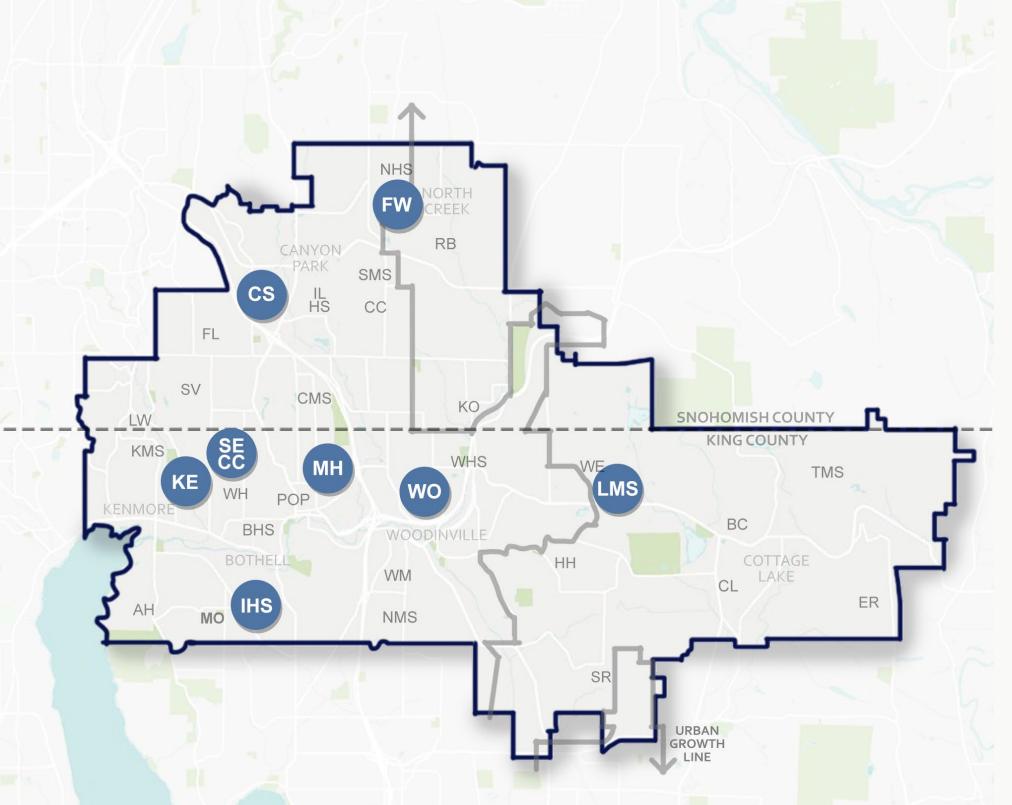


BUILDING CONDITION - \$400M
