Northshore Students Return to Buildings for Hybrid Learning

Ruby Bridges Elementary opens doors to students for first day of in-person instruction

Bothell, Wash. – On Monday, April 5 the Northshore School District welcomed back students in grades K-5, along with students in the District's Adult Transition Program, and Functional Skills and Academics (FSA) program. Early Childhood Education & Assistance Program (ECEAP), Headstart started in-person learning last week.
