3. AP Exam Information

Hello families of AP students! Thank you for registering your student for the AP Exam(s). The next step is to *pay* for the exam(s). This year we are piloting a new program for payment that is hopefully easier and more convenient for you and your student.

You may pay for exams on <u>TouchBase</u>, which is the site where you have paid for all school fees like yearbook, class fees, unpaid fines, PE uniforms, etc. The fees for exams are **\$108 each**, with the exception of Research and Seminar which are **\$145 each**.

Once your exam(s) have been paid in full, they will be ordered. **Please note: Exams will not be ordered unless paid in full. Deadline to pay is Nov. 1st, 2022**

If you need financial assistance, or would like to apply for Free/Reduced school fees, please pick up a form in my office, fill it out and turn it in at the Cashier's window by the main office (various language options available on request). If you would like to pay in person at school, you may pay by cc or check at the Cashier's window, as well.

8. World Language Competency Testing 2022

Dear North Creek Families,

Today, Saturday, October 8, registration opens for participation in World Language Competency Testing here at North Creek High School. Registration will close on Friday, October 21. This is an opportunity for students who can read, write, listen, and speak a language other than English to earn up to four competency credits and/or the Seal of Biliteracy designation on their high school transcript. More detailed information about the test and earning credits can be found on the World Language Competency Test website.

Here is the pertinent information regarding the upcoming testing opportunity:

- **Date/Time:** Tuesday, November 15th from 8:15-3:15. Check in can be 15 minutes beforehand.
- Location: North Creek High School
- The test is open to students in grades 9 through 12
- The test registration is open from Oct. 8 through Oct. 21
- Students who test are excused from class but are responsible for making up any classwork they miss
- On test day, students will return to class when they are finished with their World Language Competency Test
