

# 4. Spring SAT test at NCHS

SAT School Day allows for students to take the SAT during the school day at their home high school. The SAT School Day exam for North Creek is set for March 22. The exam will start in the AM and will last approximately 3 1/2 hours.

Important information regarding the registration and payment of the exam:

Students register for the SAT School Day exam by going to <a href="https://www.regismart.net/#/login">https://www.regismart.net/#/login</a>. Here, students will:

- CREATE ACCOUNT
- Select North Creek
- Register, and pay for the exam
- Details of the registration, fee, cancellation policy, are listed on the RegiSmart website



Please note: there is a maximum of 100 students who can take the SAT at NCHS.



# 1. COVID Update

The Department of Health (DOH) requires schools to inform families and students of COVID-19 cases and potential outbreaks. Last week, there were a total of **5** confirmed cases in students who attend North Creek. The accuracy of our data depends on self-reporting. Thank you for continuing to let the school know if your child tests positive for COVID-19. To view additional information, including school and district trends visit the <u>District's COVID-19 data dashboard</u>. The dashboard is updated weekly on Monday evenings.

If your child is exhibiting <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u> please keep them home and test for COVID-19. Families can order <u>free COVID-19</u> tests from the state. Together, we can keep our schools healthy and safe.
