Summer School is an opportunity for secondary stu	dents to strengthen skills, retrieve credit and build flexibility into the
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Summer School is an opportunity for secondary students to strengthen skills, retrieve credit and build flexibility into their schedules. High school students can earn .5 or 1.0 credit (course dependent) per class in approximately six weeks. Students must make a serious commitment to the experience in order to successfully complete the requirements. The following list of policies and regulations ensure an optimal learning environment that protects the safety and rights of all students.

Attendance and Tardies

Students must attend every day of Summer School. Northshore School District requires 90 "Content" hours for every .5 credit and 45 hours for credit retrieval. **More than two (2) absences may result in loss of credit and an "F" on your transcript.** Students must arrive on time to class since detention can be assigned for tardies. Three tardies equal one absence. Excessive tardies that equal two (2) absences may result in loss of credit.

Withdrawals and Refunds

- If a student must withdraw from a class, it must be done within the first 3 days of summer school in order to not receive an "F" on your transcript. Please communicate withdrawal information to ssummerschool@nsd.org.
- A refund of 60% is approved for withdrawals before or on the first day of Summer School, 50% on day two, and 40% on day three.
- No refunds will be issued after the third day of classes.

General Campus Regulations

- 1. Summer School maintains a closed campus. Once students arrive on campus, they cannot leave during breaks or between classes. Visitors must check in at the summer school office.
- 2. Students may not disrupt other classes or endanger people or school property.
- 3. Students shall wear clothing that is appropriate and preserves modesty, no bare midriff or underwear showing. Clothing with print or pictures that involve drugs, tobacco, sex, or improper language will not be permitted at Summer Academy. All students shall wear shoes.
- 4. Inappropriate, rude, or disrespectful language is unacceptable.
- 5. All students will be in a classroom during class time. No loitering is permitted in the halls, parking lots, or other parts of the school premises. Personal business must be conducted during transition time.
- 6. If a student is caught cheating on a class assignment or exam, the student will receive a failing grade for that assignment or exam. Make-up or retake is not permitted. A student caught helping another student cheat will follow the district policy.
- 7. Student drivers who race, "squeal," speed, or operate a motor vehicle in a reckless manner on school property or park in an unauthorized area will lose the privilege of bringing their vehicle on campus.
- 8. Audio systems (e.g. but not limited to headphones, iPods, cell phones, pagers, etc.) are not allowed during class time.
- 9. Students are allowed to bring plain water in appropriate containers into the classroom. All food and drink (other than water) must be consumed outside of class time. Trash must be placed in the appropriate containers. Please recycle. Classrooms and the campus must be maintained in good condition.
- 10. In addition to the campus regulations listed above, students are expected to comply with the teachers' class rules and the Northshore Handbook of Rights and Responsibilities.
- 11. Student discipline involving "exceptional misconduct" as listed in the <u>Northshore Handbook of Rights and Responsibilities</u> will be cause for removal without credit or refund of tuition.

Out of District Students

- 1. A copy of the current immunization form is required.
- 2. Report Cards will be mailed to the home address. Take it to your school's registrar to receive Summer School credit.
